What is PCTPA?

The Placer County Transportation Planning Agency (PCTPA) is the state-designated agency to handle regional transportation issues for Placer County. Simply put, PCTPA plans major transportation projects in Placer County and put together the funding.

To pull together the funding, we have to make sure we comply with all the strings attached, including developing plans, prioritizing projects, and then making sure the projects are completed on time and on budget.

We deal with all regional transportation modes, including:

- Highways/Roads
- Transit
- Rail
- Airports
- Bicycle/Pedestrian
- Rideshare/alternative transportation

The PCTPA Board of Directors is comprised of eight elected officials and one citizen appointee that represent each of the jurisdictions of Placer County. These nine Boardmembers oversee the seven member PCTPA staff.
